

**Final Determination** 

under the

**Biodiversity Conservation Act 2016** 

The Scientific Committee established under the *Biodiversity Conservation Act 2016* has made a final determination under the Act, Part 4, Division 3 to list a species as an endangered species and, as a consequence, omit a reference to that species as a vulnerable species.

Accordingly, the Act, Schedule 1 is amended as follows-

(a) Part 2, Division 1 is amended by inserting at the end of the table under the heading Birds—

## Petroicidae

Melanodryas cucullata cucullata (Latham, 1801) South-eastern Hooded Robin

(b) Part 3, Division 1 is amended by omitting from the matter relating to Petroicidae—

Melanodryas cucullata cucullata (Latham, 1801)	Hooded Robin
	(south-eastern form)
