1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Amendment (Dubbo) Regulation 2023*.

2 Commencement

3 Amendment of Environmental Planning and Assessment Regulation 2021

(1) Section 61 Additional matters that consent authority must consider

Omit “or Warrumbungle Shire or in the part of the local government area of Dubbo Regional that was formerly in the City of Dubbo” from section 61(3)(a).

Insert instead “, Warrumbungle Shire or Dubbo Regional”.

Consideration of Dark Sky Planning Guideline
