Explanatory note

The object of this regulation is to amend the Road Transport (Driver Licensing) Regulation 2017 to prescribe—

- (a) a further trial period for the demerit points reduction trial, and
- (b) the date on which the *Road Transport Act 2013*, sections 32A and 31(5)(b) expire.

1 Name of regulation

This regulation is the Road Transport (Driver Licensing) Amendment (Demerit Points Reduction Trial) Regulation 2024.

2 Commencement

This regulation commences on the day on which it is published on the NSW legislation website.

Schedule 1 Amendment of Road Transport (Driver Licensing) Regulation 2017

Clause 72

Insert after clause 71—

72 Demerit points reduction trial—the Act, s 32A

- (1) For the Act, section 32A(2), definition of *trial period*, paragraph (a), the period starting on 17 January 2024 and ending on 16 January 2025 is prescribed.
- (2) To avoid doubt, subclause (1) does not affect the trial period specified in the Act, section 32A(2), definition of *trial period*, paragraph (b).
- (3) For the Act, section 32A(3)(b), 31 January 2026 is prescribed.
