Explanatory note

The object of this regulation is to amend the *Government Sector Employment Regulation 2014* to—

- (a) prescribe the Minister for Customer Service and Digital Government as an authorised person to whom certain functions under the *Government Sector Employment Act 2013* (*the Act*) may be delegated, and
- (b) make other minor consequential changes.

This regulation is made under the Act, including section 88, the general-regulation making power.

1 Name of regulation

This regulation is the *Government Sector Employment Amendment Regulation 2024*.

2 Commencement

This regulation commences as follows—

- (a) for Schedule 1[2]–[4]—on 1 July 2024,
- (b) otherwise—on the day on which it is published on the NSW legislation website.

Schedule 1 Amendment of Government Sector Employment Regulation 2014

[1] **Clause 6B**

Insert after clause 6A—

6B Delegation

For the Act, section 81(2), definition of *authorised person*, the Minister administering the *Service NSW (One-stop Access to Government Services) Act 2013* is an authorised person.

[2] **Clause 10A Overseas trade employees**

Omit clause 10A(1), definition of *overseas trade employee*, paragraph (a). Insert instead—

- (a) is employed in either of the following departments (a *relevant Department*) to work in the area of international trade and investment—
- (i) the Department of Creative Industries, Tourism, Hospitality and Sport,
 - (ii) the Premier’s Department, and

[3] **Clause 10A(2), (4) and (6)**

Omit “the Department” wherever occurring. Insert instead “the relevant Department”.

[4] **Clause 10A(3)**

Omit “the Secretary”. Insert “a Secretary”.
