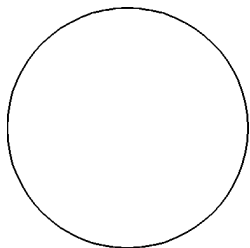

Water Management (Application of Act to North Western Water Source) Proclamation 2024

1 Name of Proclamation

This Proclamation is the *Water Management (Application of Act to North Western Water Source) Proclamation 2024*.

2 Commencement

This Proclamation commences on the date on which it is published on the NSW Legislation website.

3 Application of the Act, Chapter 3, Parts 2 and 3 to the North Western Water Source, access licences and approvals

- (1) It is declared that the Act, Chapter 3, Part 2 applies to the North Western Water Source to which the prescribed water sharing plan applies in relation to all categories and subcategories of access licences for that water source other than floodplain harvesting (regulated river) access licences and floodplain harvesting (unregulated river) access licences, to the extent that that Part did not apply immediately before the commencement of this proclamation.
- (2) It is declared that the Act, Chapter 3, Part 3 applies to the North Western Water Source to which the prescribed water sharing plan applies in relation to all approvals for that water source other than drainage work approvals and aquifer interference approvals, to the extent that that Part did not apply immediately before the commencement of this proclamation.
- (3) In this clause:

prescribed water sharing plan means the *Water Sharing Plan for the North Western Unregulated and Fractured Rock Water Sources 2024*.

the Act means the *Water Management Act 2000*.
