The object of this regulation is to amend the *Workers Compensation Regulation 2016* to provide that the State Insurance Regulatory Authority may disclose information to a person appointed under the *Government Sector Employment Act 2013*, section 82 to conduct a special inquiry into the Authority.

1 Name of regulation

This regulation is the Workers Compensation Amendment (Information Disclosure) Regulation 2024.

Schedule 1 Amendment of Workers Compensation Regulation 2016

Clause 165A

Insert after clause 165—

165A Disclosure of information to person conducting special inquiry—the 1998 Act, ss 243(2) and 243AA(2)

- (1) For the 1998 Act, sections 243(2)(d) and 243AA(2)(b), a person appointed under the *Government Sector Employment Act 2013*, section 82 to conduct a special inquiry into a matter relating to the Authority is prescribed.
- (2) In this clause— *Authority* includes the Nominal Insurer.
