## **Explanatory note**

The object of this regulation is to provide for the application for a specific purpose access licence by Sydney Water Corporation allowing access to stormwater for the purposes of stormwater harvesting and management in the Mamre Road precinct and Western Sydney Aerotropolis.

This regulation is made under the *Water Management Act 2000*, including sections 57(2) and 61(1)(a).

### **1 Name of regulation**

This regulation is the *Water Management (General) Amendment (Specific Purpose Access Licences) Regulation 2024*.

### **[1]    Section 10 Applications for specific purpose access licences**

Insert after section 10(1)(s)—

- (t) an unregulated river access licence, subcategory “Mamre Road precinct and Western Sydney Aerotropolis stormwater management”, if the application is made by Sydney Water Corporation for the purpose of enabling stormwater to be taken from—
  - (i) land in the Mamre Road precinct, identified as Precinct 12 as shown on the State Environmental Planning Policy (Western Sydney Employment Area) 2009 Land Application Map Sheet LAP\_001, and
  - (ii) land identified by the area shaded white as shown on the State Environmental Planning Policy (Precincts—Western Parkland City) 2021 Land Application Map—Aerotropolis Sheet LAP\_001.
