Public Health Amendment (Interstate Prohibition Orders) Regulation 2024

Her Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has made the following regulation under the *Public Health Act 2010*.

Explanatory note

The object of this regulation is to amend the *Public Health Regulation 2022* to extend the application of certain provisions of the *Public Health Act 2010* to persons who are subject to an interim prohibition order issued in another State or Territory, or an order under the *Health and Disability Services (Complaints) Act 1995* of Western Australia, Part 3D, Division 1 or 2.

This regulation is made under the *Public Health Act 2010*, including sections 101(1), definition of *corresponding interstate prohibition order* and 134, the general regulation-making power.

1 Name of regulation

This regulation is the *Public Health Amendment (Interstate Prohibition Orders) Regulation 2024*.

2 Commencement

Schedule 1 Amendment of Public Health Regulation 2022

[1] Section 117 Corresponding interstate prohibition orders

Insert after section 117(b)—

- (b1) an interim prohibition order made under the *Health Practitioner Regulation National Law Act 2009* of Queensland, Schedule, as it applies as a law of a State or Territory,

[2] Section 117(e)

Omit the paragraph. Insert instead—

- (e) an order made under the *Health and Disability Services (Complaints) Act 1995* of Western Australia, Part 3D, Division 1 or 2.
