# Trees (Disputes Between Neighbours) Regulation 2024

## Explanatory note

The object of this regulation is to repeal and remake, without substantive changes, the *Trees (Disputes Between Neighbours) Regulation 2019*, which would otherwise be repealed on 1 September 2024 by the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1989*, section 10(2).

This regulation prescribes certain plants as trees for the purposes of the *Trees (Disputes Between Neighbours) Act 2006*.

This regulation comprises or relates to matters set out in the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1989*, namely—

- (a) matters of a machinery nature, and
- (b) matters that are not likely to impose an appreciable burden, cost or disadvantage on a sector of the public.

## Trees (Disputes Between Neighbours) Regulation 2024

under the

Trees (Disputes Between Neighbours) Act 2006

### 1 Name of regulation

This regulation is the *Trees (Disputes Between Neighbours) Regulation 2024*.

### 2 Commencement

This regulation commences on the day on which it is published on the NSW legislation website.

**Note—** This regulation repeals and replaces the *Trees (Disputes Between Neighbours) Regulation 2019*, which would otherwise be repealed on 1 September 2024 by the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1989*, section 10(2).

### 3 Definition

In this regulation—

**the Act** means the *Trees (Disputes Between Neighbours) Act 2006*.

**Note—** The Act and the *Interpretation Act 1987* contain definitions and other provisions that affect the interpretation and application of this regulation.

### 4 Prescribed plants—the Act, s 3

For the Act, section 3(1), definition of **tree**, the following plants are prescribed—

- (a) bamboo,
- (b) tiger grass/giant clumping grass (*Thysanolaena latifolia*),
- (c) a vine.

### 5 Repeal and savings

- (1) The *Trees (Disputes Between Neighbours) Regulation 2019* is repealed.
- (2) An act, matter or thing that, immediately before the repeal of the *Trees (Disputes Between Neighbours) Regulation 2019*, had effect under that regulation continues to have effect under this regulation.
