Scrap Metal Industry (Transitional) Amendment Regulation 2024

under the

Scrap Metal Industry Act 2016

Her Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has made the following regulation under the *Scrap Metal Industry Act 2016*.

Explanatory note

The object of this regulation is to require existing scrap metal dealers to give the Commissioner of Police the additional registration information for the registered business carried on by the scrap metal dealer by 1 December 2024. If an existing scrap metal dealer fails to give the additional registration information, the Commissioner may suspend the registration of the business.

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1 Name of regulation

This regulation is the *Scrap Metal Industry (Transitional) Amendment Regulation 2024*.

2 Commencement

This regulation commences on 1 September 2024.

Schedule 1 **Amendment of Scrap Metal Industry Regulation 2024**

Section 15

Insert after section 14—

15 **Registration information**

- (1) An existing scrap metal dealer must give the Commissioner any additional registration information for the registered business carried on by the scrap metal dealer by 1 December 2024.
- (2) If an existing scrap metal dealer fails to give the additional registration information under subsection (1), the Commissioner may, by written notice, suspend the registration of the business.
- (3) In this section—

existing scrap metal dealer means a scrap metal dealer who, at the commencement of this section, is carrying on a registered business.

additional registration information, for a registered business, means the registration information for the business under the Act, section 6(2)(c1), (d1), (d2) and (e) that the scrap metal dealer carrying on the business has not, at the commencement, already given the Commissioner.
