## Explanatory note

The object of this regulation is to repeal the declaration of government policies that the Statutory and Other Offices Remuneration Tribunal is to give effect to when determining the remuneration of certain office holders.

This regulation is consequent on the repeal of the *Industrial Relations Commission Act 1996*, section 146C by the *Industrial Relations Amendment Act 2023*, which repealed a similar requirement for the Industrial Relations Commission to give effect to government policies when making or varying awards or orders relating to the employment of public sector employees.
