Explanatory note

The objects of this regulation are—

- (a) to apply provisions of the *Local Government Act 1993* relating to sewerage to certain land in the City of Hawkesbury local government area, and
- (b) to update a provision relating to the carrying out of certain activities under an approval or licence under the *Water Industry Competition Act 2006*, as a consequence of the commencement of the *Water Industry Competition Amendment Act 2021* on 1 March 2024.

1 Name of regulation

This regulation is the *Local Government (General) Amendment (City of Hawkesbury) Regulation 2024*.

2 Commencement

This regulation commences on 1 March 2024.

[1] Section 48 Activities for which approval is not required

Omit section 48(g). Insert instead—

(g) **Activities authorised by approval or licence under Water Industry Competition Act 2006**

An activity referred to in the Act, section 68, Table, Part B or C if it is carried out under the authority of an approval or licence in force under the *Water Industry Competition Act 2006*.

140 Application of the Act, Chapter 6, Part 3, Division 2 to City of Hawkesbury

(1) For the Act, section 56(3), the land within the City of Hawkesbury area identified on the Windsor Sewerage Scheme Map is prescribed.

(2) In this section—

Windsor Sewerage Scheme Map means the Windsor Sewerage Scheme Map, a public survey, identified as PP5506 and kept in the register of public surveys under the *Surveying and Spatial Information Act 2002*.
