Explanatory note

The object of this regulation is to amend the *Surveillance Devices Regulation 2022* to authorise the Attorney General to delegate certain functions under the *Surveillance Devices Act 2007* to certain employees of the department in which that Act is administered.

1 Name of regulation

This regulation is the Surveillance Devices Amendment (Delegation) Regulation 2024.

2 Commencement

This regulation commences on the day on which it is published on the NSW legislation website.

Schedule 1 Amendment of Surveillance Devices Regulation 2022

Section 6

Insert after section 5—

6 Delegation by Attorney General—the Act, s 51B

- (1) The Attorney General may delegate a function of the Attorney General under the Act, Part 3 or 5 to a person who is—
 - (a) an Australian legal practitioner, and
 - (b) employed in the department in which the Act is administered as—
 - (i) a Public Service senior executive, or
 - (ii) a legal officer grade 6 or clerk grade 11 or 12 in the legal branch, however described, of the department.
- (2) In this section—

Public Service senior executive has the same meaning as in the Government Sector Employment Act 2013.
