Explanatory note

The object of this regulation is to remove provisions relating to the Net Zero Emissions and Clean Economy Board, which has been abolished by the Minister administering the *Climate Change (Net Zero Future) Act 2023* under that Act, Schedule 2, section 2.

This regulation is made under the *Energy and Utilities Administration Act 1987*, including sections 34W and 53, the general regulation-making power.
