Explanatory note

The object of this order is to amend the *Public Health Act 2010* (***the Act***), Schedules 1 and 2 to—

- (a) add Buruli ulcer (*Mycobacterium ulcerans* infection) and Vibriosis to the list of Category 3 medical conditions under the Act, Schedule 1, and
- (b) remove Giardiasis and Typhus (epidemic) from the list of Category 3 medical conditions under the Act, Schedule 1, and
- (c) remove Typhus (epidemic) from the list of notifiable diseases under the Act, Schedule 2.

This order is made under Henry VIII provisions that enable the making of orders to amend the Act, Schedules 1 and 2.
