# **Water Management (General) Amendment (Floodplain Harvesting Access Licences) Regulation 2025**

## **Explanatory note**

The objects of this regulation are—

- (a) to include the issue of a replacement floodplain harvesting access licence under the *Water Management Act 2000*, section 57A as a Ministerial action, and
- (b) to update the floodplain boundary for the Murrumbidgee River Floodplain.

### **1 Name of regulation**

This regulation is the *Water Management (General) Amendment (Floodplain Harvesting Access Licences) Regulation 2025*.

### **2 Commencement**

This regulation commences as follows—

- (a) for Schedule 1[2]–[4]—on 1 July 2025,
- (b) otherwise—on the day on which the regulation is published on the NSW legislation website.

## Schedule 1 Amendment of Water Management (General) Regulation 2018

[1] **Clause 23M**

Insert after clause 23L—

**23M Ministerial action**

For the Act, Dictionary, definition of ***Ministerial action***, paragraph (i), the issue of a replacement floodplain harvesting access licence is prescribed.

[2] **Clause 252 Land declared to be a floodplain**

Omit “Floodplain.” from clause 252(1)(f). Insert instead—

Floodplain, and

- (g) the land shown shaded grey, including any part of the shaded area marked as road, rail, river or creek, on the map in Schedule 6, Part 7 is declared to be the Murrumbidgee Valley Floodplain.

[3] **Clause 252(2)(e), (f) and (n)**

Omit the paragraphs.
