1 Name of regulation

This regulation is the Passenger Transport (General) Amendment (Urinary Drug Testing) Regulation 2025.

2 Commencement

Schedule 1 Amendment of Passenger Transport (General) Regulation 2017

[1] Clause 107 Interpretation

Omit "for the purposes of AS/NZS 4308:2008" from clause 107(1), definition of *approved laboratory*, paragraph (b).

Insert instead "for AS/NZS 4308:2023".

[2] Clause 107(1)

Omit the definition of AS/NZS 4308:2008. Insert instead—

AS/NZS 4308:2023 means AS/NZS 4308:2023, Procedures for specimen collection and the detection and quantification of drugs in urine.

[3] Clause 107(1), definition of "on-site drug screening device"

Omit "Table 1 of AS/NZS 4308:2008". Insert instead "AS/NZS 4308:2023, table 3.1".

[4] Clause 117 Action to be taken in relation to urine samples

Omit "section 2 of AS/NZS 4308:2008" wherever occurring in clause 117(1), (3) and (8). Insert instead "AS/NZS 4308:2023, section 2".

[5] Clause 117(4)(b)

Omit "section 4 of AS/NZS 4308:2008". Insert instead "AS/NZS 4308:2023, section 5".

[6] Clause 118 Analysis of samples

Omit "sections 4 and 5 of AS/NZS 4308:2008" from clause 118(3)(a).

Insert instead "AS/NZS 4308:2023, sections 5 and 6".
