EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

This Bill is cognate with the Transport Authorities (Railway Safety) Amendment Bill 1987.

The object of this Bill is to repeal section 133 (1) (a) of the Government Railways Act 1912 as a consequence of the proposed transfer to the Transport Authorities Act 1980 of the offence relating to certain railway staff being found under the influence of alcohol or other drugs while on duty.
