

**MISCELLANEOUS ACTS (VICTIMS COMPENSATION)
REPEAL AND AMENDMENT BILL 1987**

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

This Bill is cognate with the Victims Compensation Bill 1987.

The object of this Bill is to repeal certain enactments and to amend certain other enactments, and to enact savings, transitional and other provisions, consequent on the enactment of the proposed Victims Compensation Act 1987.

Clause 1 specifies the short title of the proposed Act.

Clause 2 provides for the commencement of the proposed Act.

Clause 3 repeals the Criminal Injuries Compensation Act 1967 and the Criminal Injuries Compensation (Amendment) Act 1984.

Clause 4 gives effect to the Schedule of amendments.

Clause 5 gives effect to the Schedule of savings, transitional and other provisions.

Schedule 1 amends various Acts as a consequence of the enactment of the proposed Victims Compensation Act 1987.

Schedule 2 enacts savings, transitional and other provisions as a consequence of the enactment of the proposed Victims Compensation Act 1987.
