**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

**(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)**

This Bill is cognate with the Education (Ancillary Staff) Bill 1987.

The object of this Bill is to amend the Government and Related Employees Appeal Tribunal Act 1980 as a consequence of the proposed enactment of the Education (Ancillary Staff) Bill 1987, which provides for the appointment of ancillary staff in the Department of Education by the Director-General of Education.

This Bill amends the Principal Act so as—

- (a) to make express mention of a member of the ancillary staff as an “employee” under that Act, thereby ensuring that ancillary staff have a right of appeal in relation to disciplinary matters (Schedule 1 (1) (a));
- (b) to provide that the Director-General is to be regarded as the employer of the ancillary staff for the purposes of that Act (Schedule 1 (1) (c)); and
- (c) to provide that a right of appeal in relation to promotions applies only as regards permanent appointments to the position of senior clerical assistant (Schedule 1 (2)).

Clause 1 specifies the short title of the proposed Act.

Clause 2 provides for the proposed Act to commence on a day to be appointed by proclamation.

Clause 3 is a formal provision giving effect to the Schedule of amendments.

Schedule 1 effects the amendments mentioned above.
