TOW-TRUCK (AMENDMENT) BILL 1988

NEW SOUTH WALES



EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

This Bill is cognate with the Motor Traffic (Drivers' Licences) Amendment Bill 1988.

The object of this Bill is to amend the Tow-truck Act 1967 so as to allow a tow-truck driver's certificate to take the form of an endorsement on a driver's licence.

Clause 1 specifies the short title of the proposed Act.

Clause 2 provides for the commencement of the proposed Act on the date of assent.

Clause 3 is a formal provision that gives effect to the Schedule of amendments.

SCHEDULE 1—AMENDMENTS

Schedule 1 (1) amends section 11 of the Principal Act for the purpose described above.

Schedule 1 (2) makes a consequential amendment.
