

LOCAL GOVERNMENT (LIQUOR) AMENDMENT BILL 1990

NEW SOUTH WALES



EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

This Bill is cognate with the Liquor (Amendment) Bill 1990.

The object of this Bill is to amend the Local Government Act 1919 as a consequence of the enactment of the Liquor (Amendment) Act 1990 and the Registered Clubs (Amendment) Act 1990.

Clause 1 specifies the short title of the proposed Act.

Clause 2 provides for the commencement of the proposed Act.

Clause 3 proposes to amend the Local Government Act 1919:

- (a) to repeal so much of section 10 of that Act as at present excludes the operation of that Act in relation to matters dealt with by the Liquor Act 1982 (clause 3 (a)); and
- (b) to make a consequential amendment (clause 3 (b)).

Clause 4 is a transitional provision.
