STANDARD TIME (AMENDMENT) BILL 1989

NEW SOUTH WALES



EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

The Standard Time (Amendment) Act 1988 (1989 No. 1) provides for daylight saving to finish on the first Sunday in March in each year instead of the third Sunday, with effect from the current period of daylight saving (which commenced on 30 October 1988).

The object of this Bill is to amend that Act to provide that the change does not apply to the current period of daylight saving, but will apply to future periods.

Clause 1 specifies the short title of the proposed Act.

Clause 2 provides for the proposed Act to commence on assent.

Clause 3 makes the amendment mentioned above.
