EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

This Bill is cognate with the Superannuation Administration Bill 1987.

The object of this Bill is to amend the Police Association Employees (Superannuation) Act 1969 to extend to employees of the Police Association who remain contributors to the Police Superannuation Fund the improved benefits proposed for serving members of the police force who are contributors to that Fund. The improved benefits are contained in the Police Regulation (Superannuation) Amendment Bill 1987. The Bill also repeals a provision relating to appeals which is being transferred to the proposed Superannuation Administration Act 1987.
