**WORKERS' COMPENSATION (DUST DISEASES)
AMENDMENT BILL 1989**

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

This Bill is cognate with the Dust Diseases Tribunal Bill 1989.

The object of this Bill is to amend the Workers' Compensation (Dust Diseases) Act 1942 as a consequence of and in connection with the enactment of the proposed Dust Diseases Tribunal Act 1989.

Clause 1 specifies the short title of the proposed Act.

Clause 2 provides that the proposed Act will commence on a day to be appointed by proclamation.

Clause 3 substitutes section 6 (2) of the Workers' Compensation (Dust Diseases) Act 1942. The substituted provision provides that, in addition to the amounts currently payable from the Workers' Compensation (Dust Diseases) Fund, there will be payable from that Fund the costs involved in the operation of the Dust Diseases Tribunal of New South Wales.
