

**BUSINESS FRANCHISE LICENCES (TOBACCO) FURTHER
AMENDMENT BILL 1989**

NEW SOUTH WALES



EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

The object of this Bill is to amend section 41 of the Business Franchise Licences (Tobacco) Act 1987 to increase the fees to be paid for the licences under that Act from a fee of \$10 plus 30 per cent of the value of the relevant tobacco sold to a fee of \$10 plus 35 per cent of the value of the relevant tobacco sold.

The increased fee is to apply to licences which are to take effect on or after 28 August 1989.

Clause 1 specifies the short title of the proposed Act.

Clause 2 provides that the proposed Act is to be taken to have commenced on 28 July 1989.

Clause 3 amends section 41 of the Business Franchise Licences (Tobacco) Act 1987 in the manner described above.

Clause 4 provides that the amendment made by the proposed Act is to apply to and in respect of a fee payable for a licence which is to take effect on or after 28 August 1989.
