Crimes Amendment (Animal Sexual Abuse) Bill 2024

Explanatory note

This explanatory note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament.

Overview of Bill

The object of this Bill is to make amendments to the *Crimes Act 1900* and other legislation to replace the offence of bestiality with the offence of animal sexual abuse.

Outline of provisions

Clause 1 sets out the name, also called the short title, of the proposed Act.

Clause 2 provides for the commencement of the proposed Act on the date of assent to the proposed Act.

Schedule 1 Amendment of Crimes Act 1900 No 40

Schedule 1[3] omits the offences of bestiality and attempt to commit bestiality, and instead makes it an offence to do the following—

- (a) commit an act of animal sexual abuse,
- (b) authorise the commission of an act of animal sexual abuse,
- (c) commit an act of animal sexual abuse in the company of another person or persons,
- (d) attempt to commit an act of animal sexual abuse,
- (e) advertise or offer an animal for animal sexual abuse,
- (f) sell, transfer the ownership of or supply an animal with the intention the animal will be used for animal sexual abuse,

(g) purchase or obtain an animal for the purpose of animal sexual abuse.

Proposed section 79AA defines animal sexual abuse.

Schedule 1[1], [2], [4] and [5] make consequential amendments.

Schedule 1[6] provides that the offences created by the proposed amendments apply to acts done after the commencement of the proposed amendments.

Schedule 2 Consequential amendments to other Acts and regulations

Schedule 2 amends various Acts and regulations consequent on the amendments in Schedule 1.



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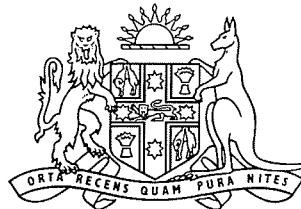

Subdivision 13 Animal sexual abuse

79AA Definitions

In this subdivision—

animal sexual abuse—

(a) includes the following—

(i) the penetration to any extent of the genitalia or anus of an animal by—

(A) a part of the body of a person, or

(B) an object manipulated by a person,

(ii) the penetration to any extent of the genitalia or anus of a person by a part of the body of an animal,

(iii) the introduction of a part of the genitalia of an animal into the mouth of a person,

(iv) the introduction of a part of the genitalia of a person into the mouth of an animal,

(v) the application of a person’s mouth or tongue to the genitalia or anus of an animal,

(vi) the application of an animal’s mouth or tongue to the genitalia or anus of a person,

(vii) other touching of an animal in circumstances where a reasonable person would consider the touching to be sexual, and the touching is done—

(A) with a part of the body of a person, or

(B) with an object manipulated by a person, or

(C) through a thing, including a thing worn by a person,

(viii) other acts carried out by a person with or on an animal that a reasonable person would consider as being intended or apparently intended to excite or gratify a sexual interest, but

(b) does not include the following—

(i) an act of veterinary science, within the meaning of the *Veterinary Practice Act 2003*,

(ii) an act carried out solely for hygienic purposes,

(iii) an act carried out to research veterinary care and treatment in accordance with an authority conferred by or under the *Animal Research Act 1985*,
