

LIQUOR FURTHER AMENDMENT) BILL 1990

NEW SOUTH WALES



EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

The object of this Bill is to amend the Liquor Act 1982:

- (a) to authorise the issue by the Liquor Administration Board of authorisations for the use by minors under adult supervision of a part of licensed premises (subject to conditions imposed by the Board as to the required level of adult supervision) to enable its use for example as a disco; and
- (b) to create a new offence which will be committed by the licensee if liquor is sold, supplied or consumed anywhere on licensed premises during a period when one of the proposed new authorisations is authorising the use by minors of any part of the premises or within 30 minutes before or after that period.

The Board can already authorise the use of a part of licensed premises by a minor in the company and immediate presence of an adult.

Clause 1 specifies the short title of the proposed Act.

Clause 2 provides for the commencement of the proposed Act on the date of assent.

Clause 3 gives effect to the Schedule of proposed amendments to the Principal Act.

Schedule 1 makes the amendments described above.
