

TRANSPORT APPEAL BOARDS (AMENDMENT) BILL 1988

NEW SOUTH WALES



EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

The object of this Bill is to amend the Transport Appeal Boards Act 1980 so that 2 Vice-Chairmen of the Transport Appeal Boards may be appointed. Each Vice-Chairman will hold office on a part-time basis. The Act presently enables one Vice-Chairman to be appointed to hold office on either a full-time or a part-time basis.

Clause 1 specifies the short title of the proposed Act.

Clause 2 is a formal provision that gives effect to the Schedule of amendments.

SCHEDULE 1—AMENDMENTS

Section 6 (Vice-Chairmen)

Schedule 1 (2) amends section 6 of the Principal Act to provide for the appointment by the Governor of not more than 2 Vice-Chairmen to hold office part-time.

Consequential amendments

Schedule 1 (1), (3), (4) and (5) make consequential amendments to sections 4, 7, 8, 18, 31 and 32 of the Principal Act.

As a consequence of the repeal of section 6 (1) of the Principal Act the office of Vice-Chairman is declared vacant (Schedule 1 (6)).
