

**PUBLIC HEALTH (WORKERS COMPENSATION)
AMENDMENT BILL 1987**

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

This Bill is cognate with the Workers Compensation Bill 1987.

The object of this Bill is to repeal Part VIIA (use of dangerous substances) of the Public Health Act 1902 as a consequence of the enactment of the proposed Occupational Health and Safety (Workers Compensation) Amendment Act 1987.

Clause 1 specifies the short title of the proposed Act.

Clause 2 specifies that the proposed Act will, with minor exceptions, commence on a day to be proclaimed by the Governor-in-Council.

Clause 3 repeals Part VIIA of the Principal Act as a consequence of the enactment of the proposed Occupational Health and Safety (Workers Compensation) Amendment Act 1987. The provisions currently in Part VIIA will be the subject of regulations under the Occupational Health and Safety Act 1983.
