**FACTORIES, SHOPS AND INDUSTRIES (CHRISTMAS  
TRADING) AMENDMENT BILL 1990**

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

**(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)**

The object of this Bill is to amend the Factories, Shops and Industries Act 1962 so as to allow any shop to trade on the two Sundays immediately before Christmas Day in each year. At present, shops other than small shops and "scheduled shops" (being certain specialised shops such as newsagencies, chemists shops and food shops) are prohibited from trading on Sundays unless specifically exempted (under section 78A of the Act) from that prohibition.

**Clause 1** specifies the short title of the proposed Act.

**Clause 2** provides for commencement of the proposed Act on the date of assent.

**Clause 3** amends section 84 of the Principal Act to give effect to the object stated above.
