WATER LEGISLATION (REPEAL, AMENDMENT AND SAVINGS) BILL 1987

NEW SOUTH WALES



EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

This Bill is cognate with the Water Supply Authorities Bill 1987.

The objects of this Bill are—

- (a) to repeal the Acts being replaced by the proposed Water Supply Authorities Act 1987 and the proposed Water Board Act 1987;
- (b) to amend certain Acts as a consequence of the enactment of the proposed Acts; and
- (c) to provide for consequential savings and transitional provisions.

Clause 1 specifies the short title of the proposed Act.

Clause 2 provides for the proposed Act to commence on the commencement of the proposed Water Supply Authorities Act 1987.

Clause 3 provides for the interpretation of the proposed Act.

Clause 4 provides for the repeal of the legislation listed in Schedule 1 that is proposed to be superseded.

Clause 5 effects the proposed amendments to various Acts as listed in Schedule 2.

Water Legislation (Repeal, Amendment and Savings) 1987

Clause 6 provides for the consequential savings and transitional provisions in accordance with Schedule 3.
