TOURISM COMMISSION (AMENDMENT) BILL 1987

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

The object of this Bill is to amend the Tourism Commission Act 1984 so as to increase by 2 the number of members who may be appointed to the Tourism Commission.

Clause 1 specifies the short title of the proposed Act.

Clause 2 provides for the proposed Act to commence on a day to be appointed by proclamation of the Governor-in-Council published in the Gazette.

Clause 3 replaces the existing section 4 (3) of the Principal Act. The new subsection provides for the appointment by the Governor of a minimum of 7 members (presently 5) and a maximum of 9 members (presently 7) to the Tourism Commission.
