Health Insurance Levies Amendment Bill 2024

Explanatory note

This explanatory note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament.

Overview of Bill

The object of this Bill is to provide for a new prescribed rate under the *Health Insurance Levies Act 1982* that is used to calculate the monthly levy payable under the Act.

Outline of provisions

Clause 1 sets out the name, also called the short title, of the proposed Act.

Clause 2 provides for the commencement of the proposed Act.

Schedule 1 Amendment of Health Insurance Levies Act 1982 No 159

Schedule 1[1] and [3] provide for a base rate of \$3.27 to have effect as the prescribed rate under the *Health Insurance Levies Act 1982* (the *principal Act*) unless a different base rate is declared by regulations under the principal Act. The prescribed rate is the rate used to calculate the monthly levy payable under the principal Act.

Schedule 1[4] enables regulations under the principal Act to declare a base rate. A regulation declaring a base rate cannot be made after the base rate is automatically adjusted under the principal Act in 2025. The amendment also provides that a regulation declaring a base rate is an excluded instrument for the purposes of the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1989*.

Schedule 1[2] makes a consequential amendment.
