Local Land Services Amendment (Private Native Forestry) Bill 2022

Explanatory note

This explanatory note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament.

Overview of Bill

The object of this Bill is to amend the *Local Land Services Act 2013*, section 60ZY(4) to provide that if an approval is given by Local Land Services under that Act, Part 5B (Private native forestry) to a private native forestry plan, the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*, Part 5 does not apply to forestry operations carried out under the plan.

Outline of provisions

Clause 1 sets out the name, also called the short title, of the proposed Act.

Clause 2 provides for the commencement of the proposed Act on the date of assent to the proposed Act.

Clause 3 gives effect to the object of the proposed Act set out in the Overview.

An Act to amend the *Local Land Services Act 2013* in relation to approvals of private native forestry plans.

The Legislature of New South Wales enacts—

1 Name of Act

This Act is the *Local Land Services Amendment (Private Native Forestry) Act 2022*.

2 Commencement

This Act commences on the date of assent to this Act.
