EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

This Bill is cognate with the Road Improvement (Special Funding) Bill 1989.

The object of this Bill is to amend the Business Franchise Licences (Petroleum Products) Act 1987 to require all licence fees collected under that Act to be paid into the Roads and Traffic Authority Fund established under the Transport Administration Act 1988.

Clause 1 specifies the short title of the proposed Act.

Clause 2 provides that the proposed Act commences on a day to be appointed by proclamation.

Clause 3 amends the Business Franchise Licences (Petroleum Products) Act 1987 in the manner described above.
