Electricity Infrastructure Investment Amendment (Tender Moratorium) Bill 2024

Explanatory note

This explanatory note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament.

Overview of Bill

The object of this Bill is to amend the *Electricity Infrastructure Investment Act 2020* to prohibit the conduct of a competitive tender for an LTES agreement until the completion of a parliamentary inquiry into the operation of that Act, including in relation to the following—

- (a) site selection,
- (b) impacts on agriculture and business,
- (c) the adequacy of regional community consultation,
- (d) the adequacy of related programs, projects, strategies and incentives for the relevant regions, including the adequacy of funding for the programs, projects, strategies and incentives.

Outline of provisions

Clause 1 sets out the name, also called the short title, of the proposed Act.

Clause 2 provides for the commencement of the proposed Act.

Schedule 1 gives effect to the object of the proposed Act.
