**DRUG MISUSE AND TRAFFICKING (FURTHER
AMENDMENT) BILL 1987**

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

The object of this Bill is to amend the Drug Misuse and Trafficking Act 1985 so as to ban—

- (a) the sale of waterpipes;
- (b) the commercial supply of waterpipes (e.g. by letting on hire); and
- (c) the commercial display of waterpipes in shops.

Waterpipes are defined as devices capable of being used for the administration of a prohibited drug by means of the drawing of smoke through water, and are commonly referred to as bongs.
