**FORESTRY (FORESTRY RIGHTS) AMENDMENT BILL
1987**

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

This Bill is cognate with the Conveyancing (Forestry Rights) Amendment Bill 1987.

The object of this Bill is to amend section 11 of the Forestry Act 1916 so as to enable the Forestry Commission to enter into agreements under which the Commission carries out silvicultural activities on private land.

Clause 1 specifies the short title of the proposed Act.

Clause 2 provides that the proposed Act will commence on the commencement of the proposed Conveyancing (Forestry Rights) Amendment Act 1987.

Clause 3 amends section 11 of the Principal Act so as to give effect to the object referred to above.
