**THEATRES AND PUBLIC HALLS (REGISTERED CLUBS)
AMENDMENT BILL 1986**

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

This Bill is cognate with the Registered Clubs (Entertainment) Amendment Bill 1986.

The object of this Bill is to amend the Theatres and Public Halls Act 1908 to apply the provisions of that Act to certain premises registered under the Registered Clubs Act 1976.

Clause 1 specifies the short title of the proposed Act.

Clause 2 provides that the proposed Act will, with minor exceptions, commence on the day on which Schedule 1 (3) to the proposed Registered Clubs (Entertainment) Amendment Act 1986 commences.

Clause 3 amends section 3A of the Principal Act to apply the provisions of that Act to functions held on the premises of a registered club which are the subject of an authority referred to in section 23 of the Registered Clubs Act 1976 in the same way as those provisions apply to a theatre or public hall or entertainment provided in a theatre or public hall.
