OMBUDSMAN (AMENDMENT) BILL 1987

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)

This Bill is cognate with the Police Regulation (Allegations of Misconduct) Amendment Bill 1987.

The object of this Bill is to amend the Ombudsman Act 1974 in consequence of the enactment of the proposed Police Regulation (Allegations of Misconduct) Amendment Act 1987.

Clause 1 specifies the short title of the proposed Act.

Clause 2 provides that the proposed Act will, with minor exceptions, commence on the day appointed and notified under section 2 of the proposed Police Regulation (Allegations of Misconduct) Amendment Act 1987.

Clause 3 amends section 5 (Interpretation) of the Principal Act to enable an investigation of prescribed conduct made pursuant to proposed section 24A (Investigation under the Ombudsman Act 1974 where complaint not dealt with in time) of the Police Regulation (Allegations of Misconduct) Act 1978 to be treated in the same way as any other investigation under the Principal Act.
