**PROBATION AND PAROLE (PAROLE BOARD)  
AMENDMENT BILL 1988**

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

**(This Explanatory Note relates to this Bill as introduced into Parliament)**

This Bill is cognate with the Prisons (Release on Licence Board) Amendment Bill 1988.

The object of this Bill is to amend the Probation and Parole Act 1983 to remove limits on the ages of Judges or retired Judges who may be appointed, and hold office, as members of the Parole Board.

**Clause 1** specifies the short title of the proposed Act.

**Clause 2** provides that the proposed Act is to commence on assent.

**Clause 3** gives effect to the Schedule of amendments.

**SCHEDULE 1—AMENDMENTS**

**Parole Board**

Schedule 1 amends Schedule 1 to the Probation and Parole Act 1983 to remove the restriction against appointing a Judge or retired Judge who is aged 72 years or more as a member of the Parole Board and to remove the requirement that such a member must retire on attaining the age of 72 years.
