1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Succession Regulation 2008*.

2 Commencement

This Regulation commences on 1 March 2008.

3 Definition

In this Regulation:

the Act means the *Succession Act 2006*.

4 Fee for deposit of a will

For the purposes of section 51 (3) of the Act, the prescribed fee to accompany a will that is deposited is \$102.
