## **Deer Regulation 2008**



Her Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has made the following Regulation under the *Deer Act 2006*.

IAN MACDONALD, M.L.C., Minister for Primary Industries

### 1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Deer Regulation 2008*.

### 2 Commencement

This Regulation commences on 17 October 2008.

### **3** Definition

In this Regulation:

the Act means the Deer Act 2006.

### 4 Authorised officers

For the purposes of section 17 (1) of the Act, persons appointed as authorised officers under section 185 of the *Rural Lands Protection Act 1998* are prescribed.

### 5 Penalty notice offences and penalties

For the purposes of section 33 of the Act:

- (a) each offence created by a provision specified in Column 1 of Schedule 1 is prescribed as a penalty notice offence, and
- (b) the penalty prescribed for each such offence is:
  - (i) in the case of an individual—the amount specified in Column 2 of Schedule 1 opposite the relevant provision, or
  - (ii) in the case of a corporation—the amount specified in Column 3 of Schedule 1 opposite the relevant provision.

### 6 Delegation of Minister's functions to authorised officers

For the purposes of section 34 of the Act, an authorised officer is authorised.
