1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the Regional Relocation Grants Regulation 2012.

2 Commencement

This Regulation commences on the day on which it is published on the NSW legislation website.

3 Definition

In this Regulation:

the Act means the Regional Relocation Grants Act 2011.
