Part 1 Preliminary

1 Name of Order

This Order is the *Fire and Emergency Services Levy (Ad Valorem Rates) Order 2017*.

2 Commencement

This Order commences on the day on which it is published on the NSW legislation website.

3 Definition

(1) In this Order:

the Act means the *Fire and Emergency Services Levy Act 2017*.

4 Ad valorem rates for 2017/2018 financial year

The ad valorem rate of the levy for the 2017/2018 financial year for each property sector is as follows:

- (a) for public benefit land—0.000219,
- (b) for farmland—0.000235,
- (c) for residential land—0.000219,
- (d) for industrial land—0.002687,

(e) for commercial land—0.001791.
