# **Constitution (COVID-19 Emergency Measures) Regulation 2020**



### 1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the Constitution (COVID-19 Emergency Measures) Regulation 2020.

### 2 Commencement

This Regulation commences on the day on which it is published on the NSW legislation website.

### 3 Definition

(1) In this Regulation—

the Act means the Constitution Act 1902.

#### Note-

The Act and the *Interpretation Act 1987* contain definitions and other provisions that affect the interpretation and application of this Regulation.

(2) Notes included in this Regulation do not form part of this Regulation.

### 3A COVID-19 pandemic—extension of prescribed period

The **prescribed period** referred to in clause 1 of Schedule 8 to the Act ends on 25 March 2021.

### 4 Special provision for Executive Council meetings during COVID-19 pandemic

- (1) During the prescribed period, a meeting of the Executive Council is to be held in person or by means of a teleconference or video conference.
- (2) During the prescribed period, the Governor, and the Vice-President or senior member if presiding in the absence of the Governor or Vice-President, respectively, is to preside at a meeting of the Executive Council in person or by means of a teleconference or video conference.
