An Act to appropriate out of the Consolidated Fund a sum for the services of the Legislature for the year 2024–25.

Part 1 Preliminary

1 Name of Act

This Act is the Appropriation (Parliament) Act 2024.

2 Commencement

This Act commences on the date of assent to this Act.

3 Definitions

(1) In this Act—

appropriation year means the year from 1 July 2024 to 30 June 2025.

services includes the following-

- (a) capital works and services,
- (b) recurrent services,
- (c) repayment of debt.
- (2) A reference in the *Government Sector Finance Act 2018* to an annual Appropriation Act includes a reference to this Act.

Part 2 Appropriation for Legislature

4 Appropriation for services of Legislature

This Act appropriates the sum of \$239,447,751 to the Legislature out of the Consolidated Fund for the services of the Legislature for the appropriation year.

Note-

The appropriation, together with funds from other sources, is intended to fund—

- (a) expenses to the sum of \$246,999,042, and
- (b) capital expenditure to the sum of \$40,093,000.

Part 3 General

5 Payments authorised on lapse of appropriation

An amount is taken to have been expended out of a sum appropriated for a purpose by this Act if the amount—

- (a) was paid for the purpose under the *Government Sector Finance Act 2018*, section 4.10, and
- (b) was paid during the appropriation year and before the date of assent to this Act.
