An Act to amend the *Road Transport Act 2013* with respect to driving safety in connection with obstructions and hazards on roads.

1 Name of Act

This Act is the *Road Transport Amendment (Obstruction and Hazard Safety) Act 2013*.

2 Commencement

This Act commences on:

- (a) the date of assent to this Act, or
- (b) if the date of assent to the *Road Transport Act 2013* is later than the date of assent to this Act—the date of assent to the *Road Transport Act 2013*.

3 Amendment of *Road Transport Act 2013*

Section 117 Negligent, furious or reckless driving Insert after section 117 (3) (b):

- (c) any obstructions or hazards on the road (including, for example, broken down or crashed vehicles, fallen loads and accident or emergency scenes).
