1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the [Health Insurance Levies Regulation 2003](#).

2 Commencement

This Regulation commences on 1 September 2003.

This Regulation replaces the [Health Insurance Levies Regulation 1997](#) which is repealed on 1 September 2003 by section 10 (2) of the [Subordinate Legislation Act 1989](#).

3 Definition

In this Regulation:

the Act means the [Health Insurance Levies Act 1982](#).
